Worm Farm

Setting up the worm farm:

- Place bedding (leaf litter, shredded cardboard or paper) in bottom of bin.
- Add a handful of worms.
- Add small amount of food scraps (ideally chopped into small pieces).
- Add a handful of grit (crushed eggshells).
- Cover with layer of carbon (handful of leaves or shredded paper).
- Cover with a blanket/hessian sack/old wooled shirt to keep them warm and cosy.

Feeding your worms:

- Don't overfeed them.
- Only add scraps once old ones have been digested.
- Add carbon every time you feed.
- Cover with a blanket/hessian sack/old wooled shirt to keep them warm and cosy.

What to feed:
